Deuteronomy 6: 1-19
New International Version - UK (NIVUK)

Love the LORD your God

6 *These are the commands, decrees and laws the LORD your God directed me to teach you to observe in the land that you are crossing the Jordan to possess,* ² *so that you, your children and their children after them may fear the LORD your God as long as you live by keeping all his decrees and commands that I give you, and so that you may enjoy long life.* ³ **Hear, Israel, and be careful to obey so that it may go well with you and that you may increase greatly in a land flowing with milk and honey, just as the LORD, the God of your ancestors, promised you.**

⁴ **Hear, O Israel: the LORD our God, the LORD is one!**^[a] ⁵ **Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.** ⁶ **These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts.** ⁷ **Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.** ⁸ **Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads.** ⁹ **Write them on the door-frames of your houses and on your gates.**

¹⁰ *When the LORD your God brings you into the land he swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, to give you – a land with large, flourishing cities you did not build,* ¹¹ *houses filled with all kinds of good things you did not provide, wells you did not dig, and vineyards and olive groves you did not plant – then when you eat and are satisfied,* ¹² **be careful that you do not forget the LORD, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.**

¹³ **Fear the LORD your God, serve him only and take your oaths in his name.** ¹⁴ **Do not follow other gods,** the gods of the peoples around you; ¹⁵ *for the LORD your God, who is among you, is a jealous God and his anger will burn against you, and he will destroy you from the face of the land.* ¹⁶ **Do not put the LORD your God to the test as you did at Massah.** ¹⁷ **Be sure to keep the commands of the LORD your God and the stipulations and decrees he has given you.** ¹⁸ **Do what is right and good in the LORD's sight, so that it may go well with you** and you may go in and take over the good land that the LORD promised on oath to your ancestors, ¹⁹ *thrusting out all your enemies before you, as the LORD said.*
