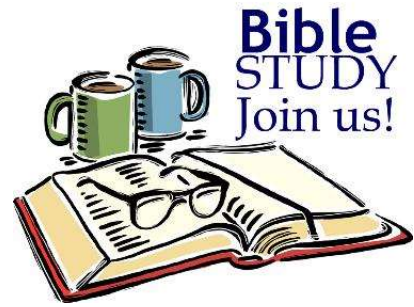

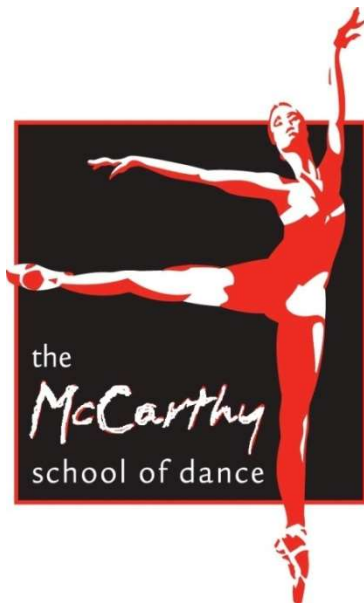

Flower Convenorship

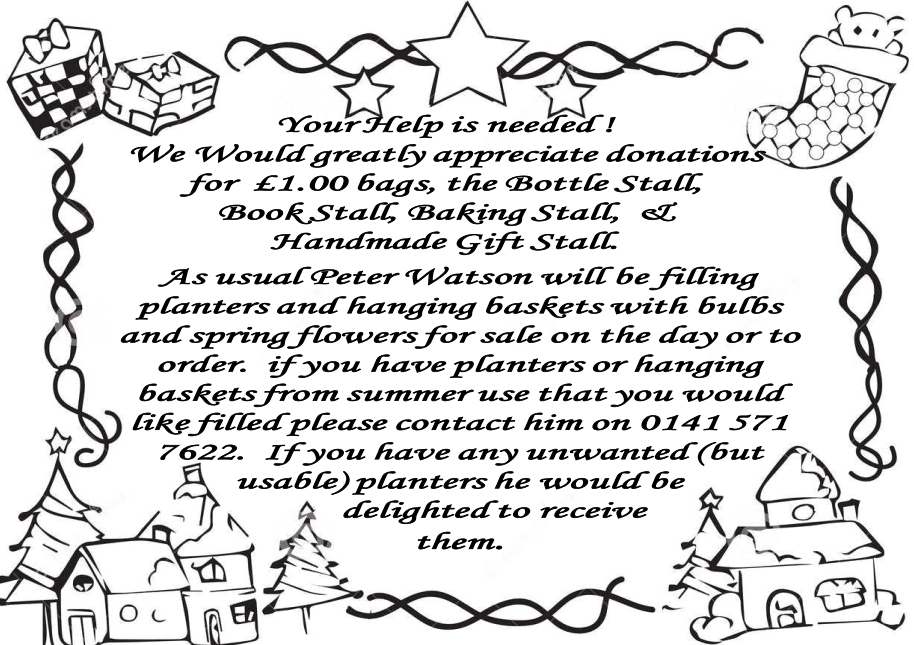

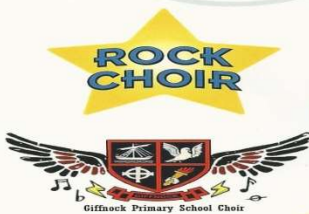
