## Sunday 17th November 2019

*I came across a text from the psalms which I thought was a lovely reference to taking heart in troubled times.*

*Psalm 73: 26 says... "My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion for ever."*

*There are those times in life when crisis descends upon us leaving us with a challenge that we struggle to cope with. Death, illness, anxiety, social pressures to conform, financial pressures to contend all remain at the heart of many people's struggles and for some these are struggles that become all consuming. These words from the Psalmist remind us that there is one to whom we can turn in these moments. It is a wonderful thing to think that God in his care for us can sustain us through what Charles Dickens referred to as "the Best of times , the worst of times". (from a Tale of Two Cities)*

*With all that is going on in the nation across our cities, towns and villages with more and more feeding from Foodbanks, more and more who are living on the streets, more and more who struggle with mental health of one form or another, we ask the question - where is the hope that they can find? For the Christian there is the hope of knowing what the psalmist knew - that God is always with us. It is his love that sustains us in these times. Enjoy Worship today and have a great week ahead.*




